<p>DD1 - Usually does not require prompts to initiate activities of self-care and daily living. May need additional time to be oriented/trained in new situations and jobs. May need adaptive supports or additional supervision when under unusual stress or in new situations. May require help in reading, writing, and preparing documentation.</p> <p>DD2 - Requires prompts to initiate/complete self-care and daily living. Needs additional time to be orientated/trained in new situations and jobs. May need help for appropriate interaction with others, following rules, and avoiding social isolation. Even with assistance, may demonstrate poor understanding of relevant issues in a hearing process. Likely to require help in reading, writing and preparing documentation. Victimization concerns.</p> <p>DD3 - Usually requires prompts to initiate/complete self-care and daily living. Needs additional time and to be orientation/training in new situations and jobs (and may never be so). Needs help for appropriate interaction with others, following rules, and avoiding social isolation. With staff assistance, unlikely to demonstrate understanding of relevant issues in a hearing process. Likely to require help in reading, writing and preparing documentation. Victimization concerns.</p>	<p>NCF - Normal cognitive functioning. Inmates/parolees who received a passing score on Phases I or II cognitive tests and did not require adaptive functioning evaluation.</p> <p>NDD - Inmate initially identified as DD0 and has been re-evaluated found not to require adaptive support services</p>
