5 1. At page 6:8-11, the text is changed to state:

9 Resp. ¶ 7.) No further authorization is required to implement this
10 measure, and Defendants estimate that implementation will reduce
11 the prison population by 1,250 inmates by December 31, 2013. (*Id.*)

12 2. At pages 28:28-29:3, the text is changed to state:

13 Defendants will increase the number of inmates placed in fire
14 camps because there are about 1,250 more of these low-level
