

FACTS TO CONSIDER BEFORE APPLYING FOR A PEACE OFFICER CAREER

- Be patient. Expect the process to take up to 12 months before you are finished. This is consistent with all law enforcement agency hiring.
- Be truthful and accurate when completing the supplemental application, the personal history statement and the background investigation questionnaire. All answers are verified during the background investigation including, but not limited to work experience, supervisory experience, college credits, college degrees, military experience, criminal record and driving history.
- Be willing to relocate and work anywhere in the state if you want to be hired into an entry level peace officer position.
- Only 3 to 4 percent of all applicants make it through the entire selection process and get hired.
